

Interesting places to visit near the Hotel Vincci Marítimo

Nova Mar Bella Beach is the closest beach to the Vincci Marítimo is, located approximately 500 to 800 metres away (approximately a 15-minute walk). It is one of the most peaceful and inclusive beaches in Barcelona, known primarily for its tranquil atmosphere, excellent accessibility, and local vibe.

Sagrada Familia is an iconic, unfinished Roman Catholic minor basilica that stands 564 feet or 172 meters, designed by renowned architect Antoni Gaudí. Known for its unique, nature-inspired architecture blending Gothic and Art Nouveau styles, it has been under construction since 1882 and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Even if you do not enter, it is worth seeing from the outside for its surrealistic, dreamlike and majestic impact. **Added note:** It is a very popular tourist site, beware of pickpockets.

Metro stop “Sagrada Familia”:
L2 - Lavender Line
L5 - Blue Line

Park Güell is a renowned public park and UNESCO World Heritage Site designed by celebrated architect Antoni Gaudí. Opened in 1926, it is a masterpiece of Catalan modernism featuring vibrant, colorful mosaics, whimsical, organic architecture, and panoramic city views.

Metro stops “Lesseps or Vallcarca”
L3 – Green

Both stations on the green line (L3), Lesseps and Vallcarca, are a similar distance from Park Güell, taking approximately 15 to 20 minutes to walk uphill. Lesseps is usually the more direct recommended option, while Vallcarca is a good alternative using the escalators at Baixada de la Glòria.

Rambla de Poblenou

Metro stop “Poblenou”: L4 – Yellow Line

La Rambla del Poblenou is an iconic pedestrian avenue approximately one kilometer long. It is the social and commercial heart of the neighborhood, known for its relaxed atmosphere, outdoor cafes, traditional shops, and historic buildings such as the Casino de la Alianza. The far end of the avenue reaches the sea.

Lunch Options for during the workshop:

Diagonal Mar Centro Comercial is the closest mall, located roughly a 5-10 minute walk from the hotel. It is one of Barcelona's largest shopping centers and features a large food court and an outdoor roof terrace called "La Terrassa del Mar" with numerous dining options.

Nova Mar Bella Beach

There are several restaurants and beach bars (chiringuitos) overlooking the sea very near Nova Mar Bella Beach. March is the beginning of the season, some may still be closed. Further information will be provided.
